PROFILE

A] Introduction

Marathi is an Indo-Aryan language. It is the official language of Maharashtra state of India and is one of the 23 official languages of India. There were 73 million speakers in 2001; Marathi has the fourth largest number of native speakers in India. The major dialects of Marathi are called Standard Marathi and Warhadi Marathi There are a few other sub-dialects like Ahirani, Dangi, Vadvali, Samavedi, Khandeshi, and Malwani etc. Standard Marathi is the official language of the State of Maharashtra. Marathi is primarily spoken in Maharashtra and parts of neighboring states of Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, Goa, Karnataka, Chhattisgarh, Telangana and Andhra Pradesh, union-territories of Daman and Diu and Dadra and Nagar Haveli. The formerly Maratha ruled cities outside Maharashtra such as Baroda, Indore, Gwalior, and Tanjore each have sizable Marathi-speaking communities. Marathi is also spoken by Maharashtrian emigrants worldwide, especially in the United States, Israel, Mauritius, and Canada.

The first known examples of the written Marathi language are found in inscriptions dating to about the 11th century. Today Marathi is most commonly written using the Devanagari script, which is also used in the Hindi and Sanskrit languages. The Sanskrit alphabet dates back to circa the 7th century AD and long served as the sacred and literary language of Hindi India. The form of Devanagari used to write Marathi is slightly different from that used to write Hindi and other Indian languages. In the Marathi language, the Devanagari script is used both for official purposes and printed literature, as well as for everyday handwriting. An alternative form of cursive Devanagari, known as *Modi*, is also used for handwritten Marathi, although less frequently.

Marathi Literature has strengthened the devotional mindset propounded by the *Bhakti* Movement in Medieval time. The credit of Monotheism in the fold of Hinduism was advocated in the literature of *Mahanubhav* and *Warkari* Sect (*Sampradaya*) enriched the Marathi language. In the middle of the 20th century, two literary trends emerged in the realm of world literature that swept away the age old notions of appreciating literature by sensitizing it with the life sufferings and livings of the marginalized societies manifested in what came to be known as the Dalit and Rural literature. Since 1990, after the acceptance of globalization the Marathi literature & language is reflecting the changes in society.

The Saraswati Bhuvan Education Society's Arts and Commerce College was established in June 1963 and got government sanction vide order of Education and Social Welfare Department, Sachivalaya, Bombay 32, No.UMF/2363/87831/U of dated 09/09/1963. The Marathi department is
