



Knowledge Research Centre (Library):

The College is having a library housed in a separate building is one of the most multifarious libraries in the region with over 97,650 books that consist of novels, textbooks, newspapers, journals, handbooks, manuscripts, dictionaries, thesauri, atlases, encyclopedias, theses, research papers, anthologies covering various subjects. An Integrated Library Management System named SOUL keeps tabs on all the biblical transactions. SOUL Software provides multilingual support for Indian as well as foreign languages. It monitors the library's user records, stock maintenance, Bar Coding, Exchange Processes, membership data etc. The library also has a repository of e-journals, e-books, and e-Shodh Sindhu along with an e-Shodh Ganga Membership.

Computer Center:

To cope up with the modern world college has set up computer centre which has 310 computers, along with 26 laptops equipped with 10 MBPS OFC Broadband Internet facility. 23 laptops are lent to the faculty members to incorporate PPTs and Audiovisual Resources in classroom teaching. During the pandemic year, the College has availed 31 licenses of CISCO Webex for the online teaching-learning process. A power generator facility is available for an uninterrupted electricity supply.

Language Lab:

SBES College of Arts & Commerce has a language lab with 30 computers supported by hardware and ACEN software. It facilitates the inclusion of language competencies in our students. Recognizing the significance of linguistic diversity and the competitive edge, our college offers multilingual courses that empower students to thrive in a globalized society. These courses are meticulously designed to enhance students' language skills and foster cultural understanding, thereby equipping them with the tools necessary for success in an increasingly interconnected world. In today's rapidly evolving educational landscape, the role of faculty members extends far beyond traditional teaching responsibilities. Recognizing the importance Faculty Development Programs are also conducted in Language Lab.



DLP Classrooms:

Historical Building of the Institute has a five-storey main building that consists of 46 well-ventilated and equipped Classrooms with White/Green boards, comfortable seating desks, ceiling fans, and tube lights including, roof mounted Projectors in classrooms. Our college has a Sophos firewall and Wi-Fi with 100 MBPS speed made available for students and staff. The college also provides power backup with a 25 KVA generator.



Dramatics & Music:

The Dramatics and Music department is housed in a separate building of 8880 Sq. Ft. with an auditorium of 200 seating capacity. The auditorium also serves as a mini theatre and drama laboratory. The classrooms of the music department are arranged in a 'Bhartiya Baithak Style' for Riyaz. The department also has musical instruments like tabla, Harmonium, Sitar, Sarod, Sarangi, Flute, Tambora, etc.



Girls Hostel:

The College provides secured and gated hostel facility to ensure safety of our female students. The hostel rooms are furnished with comfortable beds. It is equipped with security personnel and CCTV Surveillance. Wi-Fi study area, 24/7 RO drinking water and Solar water facility within the hostel premises are available. Nutritious and delicious meals are provided at hostel mess for which menu is decided by the students. Medical assistance is made available in case of emergency. Sports:

The College has a 74594 Sq. Ft. playground and a separate gymnasium of 12916 Sq. Ft. with four wooden badminton courts, table tennis facility, and multi-gym. In the last 5 Years the College has received 108 awards/medals for outstanding performance in sports as well as cultural activities at university/state/national/international level.



Campus:

The College maintains a green campus, water grid, water conservation methods like rainwater harvesting, vermin-composting, equipment's for efficient use of energy like LED, Sensors, Control Panels and 15 KV on solar energy plant. The same is prominently displayed to make students aware and sensitize them about the environmental issues.



Security:

A college environment that prioritizes safety and inclusivity is paramount. Setting up Internal Compliance Committee to resolve issues relating to girl's students, checkup camps for girls students, women's day celebration, dedicated security which includes bouncers and women security staff, full time retired police officer to enhance the security, ladies room, 128 security cameras.



Conference & Seminar Hall:

The Conference Hall is air-conditioned with DLP, internet & Sound system facilities with seating capacity for 125 people where presentations, competitions, guest lectures, workshops are organized. For a large gathering we have a well-equipped air-cooled auditorium with a seating capacity of 200 people which also serves as a theatre for students of dramatics
