Date: 18/07/2021

On 2/07/2021, an online workshop was organized on the subject of 'Research Methodology' by the Department of Economics of Saraswati Bhuvan College of Arts and Commerce. This workshop was guided by Professor Dr. Naresh Bodkhe, Gokhale Institute Pune. Speaking about Commerce Research Methodology, he elaborated on the research method to be used while collecting information. He said that it is necessary to inculcate the skills of curiosity, reading, perseverance, and awareness for research. At the same time, by taking the knowledge of the research method required for the research topic, the facts should be collected and analyzed, and arranged, and the information obtained should be presented in a suitable theoretical framework. It was also opined that the prerequisite information, observation, and survey are all important for research. At the same time, it was suggested that the research would be of higher quality if the findings at the end of the research were not presented based on prejudiced knowledge, but the matters found in the observation and survey were carefully presented.

For the research to be of high quality, the researcher must read more books, go directly to the department to which the research topic is related, participate, and present the facts obtained through observation. At the same time, it is important to carry out the research work together with the students, in cooperation with each other. He also narrated various experiences while working on various projects and writing reports.

The organizer of this online workshop Prof. Dr. Madhav Gaikwad, Head of Department of Economics, introduced the presenters and guests. The Principal, Prof. Dr. Makarand Paithankar and Vice-Principal Prof. Dr. Pramod Dev Sir were the chief presence in this program. A total of 83 students and teachers were present in the program.
